Trinity Episcopal Church is located in the historical district of Morgan City. Founded in 1984 as a mission church, it is listed on the National Historic Register. Residents of Morgan City refer to the church as "the little green church" on the corner of Second Street.

Trinity is known in the community for its many outreach endeavors: feeding first responders, providing food for school children in time of crisis, providing money for Outreach endeavors in the community, hosting community events in the Parish Hall, providing a place for Alcoholics Anonymous to meet, serving on mission trips to Honduras, serving food at a city-wide fish fry, and providing gift cards at Christmas for the elderly and teenagers.

During its 150 years, eleven priests have served as rector. Our last rector accepted a call from Texas in August 2020. The last year has been difficult with the pandemic and no services held at the church. Some faithful members stopped attending church and haven't returned yet. We are now searching for a new rector who will lead us during this challenging time.
