### *Our Retreat Leader*

Our facilitator, Katherine Martin has lived forty year of recovery in service . She has been a convener and member of ARM, facilitator of the Women’s retreat, Cursillo Leadership team, and she was the director of O’Brien House Recovery center.

### *Retreat Theme*

The theme of this weekend is “Growing in God’s Grace.” Katherine’s experience as director for 19 years at O’Brien House and staff at St. James Place retirement community has given her many experiences with people in recovery and allowed her to spend much time listening to God. She loves to write poetry and letting her angels flow onto the paper. We will have time for small group discussion to share questions and for personal exploration into our recovery journey.

The weekend begins with supper at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, August 5 and ends on Sunday, August 7, about 11am, following a 12-Step Morning Prayers. You may check in on Friday after 3:00 p.m. However, you may arrive at SECC as early as 1:00 pm on Friday. On Friday night we will gather in the lodge at 8:00 p.m. for Katherine’s first session.

***A 100% deposit is required and must be paid no later than July 1, 2022.. Partial deposit refundable upon minimum of 72 hour cancellation.***

### *Our Conference Center*

All rooms at the Conference Center are double occupancy (shared rooms). You may request a private room, but we can not guarantee their availability. Private rooms are not assigned until after all registrations are received and we know the total attendance. We assign private rooms on a “first requested, first issued” basis; but no one will be turned away in order to provide private rooms. There are two handicap accessible rooms.. Please let SECC know if you have any special dietary needs.
